

How to Create Classroom and School Data Walls

This document provides teachers and school leaders with information on how to create classroom and school data walls. It is an accompaniment to the **8 Cycles of School Practice Framework**.

About Data Walls

A data wall is a large display positioned in visible place in the school or classroom. It displays information about the programs being taught, students' lesson progression in these programs, and student results and samples of their independent work.

Data walls enable the teaching team to:

- make teaching and learning visible to all students, the teaching team and parents
- set the program goals and targets for students, track and monitor performance, and celebrate progress and successes.

Types of data displayed on a classroom data wall:

- Lesson progress goals or targets for each group of students.
- Attendance for each group of students.
- Program learning goals and matching targets for each group of students.
- Examples of exemplar work for each group of students.
